WE NEED YOUR HELP.



SCORERS. (Ad-hoc or regular)

We're on the lookout for volleyball enthusiasts who can help us score our home National Volleyball League games for Division 1, 2 and 3. This is a volunteering opportunity.

A scorer is an essential match official, whose role is vital in a national volleyball league game. The scorer uses an official scoresheet, and is responsible for tracking a number of things, including:

- the score of the game
- the progress of the game
- players positions and substitutions
- duration of sets etc.

If you want to watch some top volleyball games and help your local club succeed in developing competitive volleyball in the area, please do get in touch.

Commitment

As our club scorer, we'd love it if you could help cover some of the home games which are played in Coventry, most of the time at the Alan Higgs centre, on weekends. We'd ideally see you committed to covering one game every couple

of months. We're flexible with that, so if it feels like a big commitment, please do know we'll also take your help on an ad-hoc basis!

Support

If you've never scored before, then we'll make sure to teach you! We'll do that by inviting you to the games scheduled throughout the season, and you'll learn to score on a mockup scoresheet, guided by someone who already knows how to do it. Call it a scoring party!

If you're already a seasoned scorer, or have experience with scoring then it's even better. You might need us to remind you of a thing or two, in which case we'll make sure you have the answers you need. You might even want to join a match ahead of the one you're scoring, just to get some practice in.

The volleyball community is incredibly friendly and you'll find that the referees will also give you a hand when you're at the scoring table.

LINE JUDGES. (Ad-hoc or regular)

We're on the lookout for volleyball enthusiasts who can help us line judge our home National Volleyball League games. This is a volunteering opportunity for those keen to see competitive volleyball live, not too far from your own home!

For each home game for Divisions 1 and 2, played in Coventry, we need a total of two line judges to help our National Volleyball League games run in compliance with the rules of the league.

This is a simple volunteering opportunity, and doesn't require training, apart from understanding the hand and flag gestures you'll need to know during a game. As a line judge, you will:

- Call the ball in or out
- Call any touches on out-of-play balls
- Flag if the ball is played on the outside of the antennas.

Support

The referees brief all line judges before each game, so you don't ever need to worry about anything else on game day (apart from turning up, of course).

JUNIOR SESSION ASSISTANT. (Ad-hoc or regular)

**We need your help to support the next generation of volleyball players!
Just over a year ago we launched the Junior sessions for beginners and for advanced.**

These have been growing from 24 kids, to 64 kids, and that increase in numbers means that we really need some extra people to volunteer and help us run these sessions safely and smoothly.

All sessions are led by a coach who will have pre-planned the session. As a Junior session assistant you will:

- Help set up and direct the drills
- Occasionally help kids on a 121 basis
- Demonstrate any drills as needed
- Work with any groups of kids to make up for numbers
- Provide support to players to improve their skills and game

This role is suited for people who are already volleyball players.

All sessions have at least one adult who is DBS-checked - typically the coach.

Mondays, 19:45 - 21:45 - Advanced

Wednesdays, 19:45 - 21:45 - Beginners and intermediates
